Enrollment Fee Schedule

*Enrollment fees are a one-time administrative fee for enrollment for each student, with a family cap at two students. **All enrollment fees are non-refundable.***

Class Fees Deposit:

Class fees include all the fees associated with class enrollment for one year. Students will be charged a deposit based on number of days of enrollment at the time of enrollment. The deposit fee schedule is below. This deposit secures a spot in the desired class or classes. Deposits are non-refundable and will be deducted from your total class fees in August prior to the first payment due. This is to ensure that administration and teachers can effectively plan for the year. **All deposit fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.**

Fees

Enrollment Fees and deposits are due at the time of enrollment and are non-refundable. If a student or family ‘drops’ a single day from their original enrollment, the deposit is still non-refundable and cannot be applied toward tuition for another day or transferred to another child. A student is not considered ‘enrolled’ until enrollment fee and deposit fees are paid.

Schedule of Payments:

After full enrollment fees and deposit are paid, families will be sent a schedule of payments according to the payment option they have selected. (See “Financial Agreement”). This will be sent by the EW Administration via email. **All annual class fees become non-refundable after the first week of the school year.** This includes any students who decide to withdraw from Eagle’s Wing for any reason. (See “Financial Agreement”).

Payment Options:

Families selecting payment option 2 or option 3 will be required to provide Eagle’s Wing Resources with the full year’s payments in the form of post-dated checks (in the amount provided by EW Admin according to their class fees) at the time of the first payment. A processing fee of \$15 per check (beginning with the second payment) will be added to your payment amount. EW Admin will inform you one week prior to depositing each post-dated check.

Family Discounts:

Any household enrolling three siblings in Eagle's Wing classes during the 2026-27 school year will receive a 5% discount on all class fees. Households enrolling four or more students will receive a 10% discount on all class fees.

Discounts will apply to all class fees but will not be calculated until after enrollment is complete. In other words, all deposits will be \$300-600 (depending on number of days enrolled) regardless of pending discounts.

Financial Agreement

Eagle's Wing Learning Center is committed to keeping fees as affordable as possible and to serving our families with integrity. This includes financial accountability to the advisory committee, our teachers and our staff. Budgets and teacher contracts are written at the beginning of the academic school year based on enrollment. Therefore, each family agrees to pay their full enrollment and class fees for the entire year.

Enrollment fees and deposits paid at the time of enrollment are not refundable or transferable. Additionally, enrollment is final at the end of the first week of classes with no refunds on Class Fees.

We do offer a few payment options, including a payment plan that extends over the 2026-27 year. Our payment plan is a convenience to families. Late fees of \$50 (capped at 20% of total bill) will accrue every two weeks after payment due dates for any failed payments or returned checks. In addition, no student will be allowed to attend class until payment is received.

Eagle's Wing Learning Center Student Code of Conduct

Eagle's Wing Learning Center exists to nurture joy and creativity in learning.

Our educational philosophy follows the philosophies of Charlotte Mason education. This philosophy emphasizes that education is an atmosphere, a discipline, and a life. These 3 'prongs' of education are further guided at Eagle's Wing in the following way:

Education is an Atmosphere:

Eagle's Wing Learning Center is a co-school, operating 3 days per week. As a co-school, we partner with parents *and students* in their educational endeavor. **Parent partnership is essential to this process including but not limited to overseeing homework and integrity in at-home work. Parents retain the final responsibility to educate their children.**

All students have the right to a joyful, safe, nurturing and creative educational atmosphere. Students are responsible for their own self-regulation and academic motivation.

Eagle's Wing will provide parents and students with daily summaries of classes and homework which should be completed at home to make learning successful. This at-home component is essential to the homeschool/co-school process. Parents are responsible for providing support to their students in the way of email (or Discord) communication, home instruction, guidance and oversight in daily homework, and regular communication with teachers and staff. **Homework is expected to be completed, and parents are responsible for facilitating this essential educational component.**

Education is a Discipline:

Developing God-honoring character and habits is the goal of a Christ-centered education. Students are accountable for their classroom behavior.

Student Code of Conduct

With our ultimate goal being to glorify God, we seek to build student's character and habits of *self-control, respect, and honor for one another*. Appropriate guidelines and boundaries regarding student daily conduct should be as follows:

- **Respect** Eagle's Wing Staff and HRCC church staff~ Students should not talk back to any staff member, or speak to a staff member in a sarcastic, raised voice or a disrespectful manner. When asked to complete a task or to interact in a positive manner, students should respond in the affirmative and not 'challenge' the teacher or staff member.

- **Respect** your classmates~ this includes acting with kindness towards all students, honoring their boundaries, and always being inclusive. Students are asked to comply with appropriate behavior and talk with other students, always deferring a high standard of God-honoring conduct and talk. Crude or vulgar language should never be used.

- **Respect** church property and classroom materials~ Students are expected to care for the property and classroom materials that they are blessed to be allowed to use.
- *We understand that students may at times become overwhelmed or frustrated. When this occurs, students may take a break from the classroom for their own self-control and regulation.*
- **Students must communicate with their teacher if they need to leave the classroom for any reason, i.e., bathroom, water, etc.**
- If at any time a student's behavior is disrespectful or inappropriate, the student may be asked to take a break and sit with Mrs. Murray. The classroom and social environment at Eagle's Wing are a privilege and negative behavior may cause the student to lose this privilege.
- *If a student or parent has a concern or question regarding classroom or facility behavior or expectations, etc., this should be taken privately to the teacher first, then to the administrator or director if needed. Our door is always open, but we ask that students and parents communicate appropriately and privately rather than in an open forum.*

Education is a Life:

This philosophy within our classroom context recognizes that learning happens all the time, and not only within the 4 walls of a classroom. Outdoor learning is essential for building health, wellness and attention habits. Both outdoor nature study (the basis for science) and outdoor PE and free play are a priority and will happen every day. Students should come prepared to be outside!!

Students and parents are encouraged and responsible to complete homework. Field trips, nature study, and family and outside learning are all additionally recognized as essential to a student's education and well-being.

While at EW, students will be asked to follow rules and boundaries that are consistent with a safe and respectful classroom situation. This is because the staff at EW are responsible for their safety and well-being, and we take this very seriously!

Math instruction for kindergarten – 5th Grade students will take place three days each week (Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays). They will receive 2 hours of total instruction each week (Tuesday – 30 minutes, Wednesday- 1 hour, & Thursday – 30 minutes). Any student enrolled in a math class must attend math class all three days.

Tuesday & Thursday math classes will take place from **8:15 – 9am** for Upper Elementary before classes begin at Eagle’s Wing and during the morning hours for Lower Elementary. Wednesday math class will take place on Wednesday’s from 1:45-2:45.

A class fee of \$500 will be charged in full upon enrollment into the math program. This enrollment will act as an add-on and is separate from normal enrollment. There will be no enrollment fees or deposit required for this add on. There will only be a one-time fee of \$500 for the year.
